We welcome additional expertise across all domains covered by the Electronic Components and Systems Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda, with a special emphasis in the following topics:

- "Embedded Software and Beyond";
- "Health and Wellbeing";
- "Agrifood and Natural Resources".

Applications from SME representatives will be especially welcome.

The candidates will be assessed against the current expected requirements for the TEG and the AENEAS Management Committee will then be asked to endorse the proposed candidates.


