Beneficiaries propose Research & Innovation projects in any scientific discipline;

The MSCA Staff Exchanges is a bottom-up Action.



#### The programme is easy to manage (unit cost)

4600 EUR per month implemented by secondee, 2300 EUR for the seconded staff member and 2300 EUR for the organisation.



#### The success rate is high

Up to 40% depending on the discipline.
